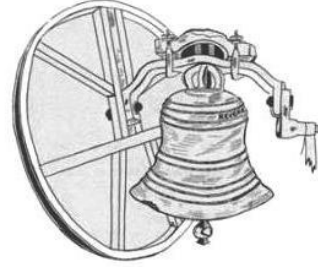
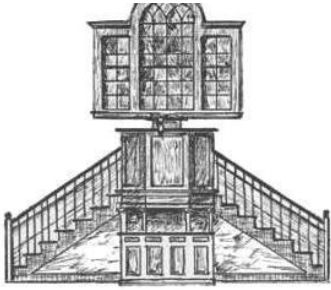

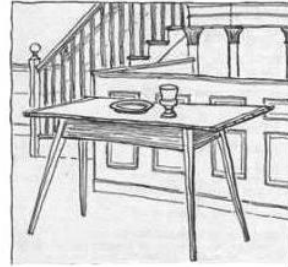

Come enjoy this time of food, fun and fellowship with your FBC family and then stroll over to the Town Green for a band concert on the common.

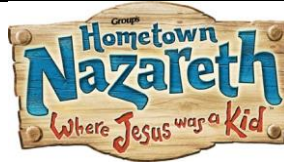
